Award in Working in Low Risk Confined Spaces (Water/Non-Water)

The Low Risk Confined Space course, (6150-01/51) is a qualification for all those who are required to work, as part of their main job, in confined spaces which have been classified as low risk.

The course supersedes the C&G Scheme 5831 Unit 821 Utility Operations.

Training is undertaken within regulation guidelines and once completed, learners should have gained enough knowledge to pass the assessment and enter low risk confined spaces.

The qualification is valid for a period of three years.

Who is the Course Suitable For?

Anyone who needs to enter a low risk confined space as part of their job will benefit from studying the City and Guilds Confined Space course. Also suitable for the construction, industrial and chemical industries.

What is Covered in the Course?

The 6150-01/51 training course has been designed for those new to the industry who would like to develop their skills and work safely in LOW RISK confined spaces to regulation standards.

The training covers all aspects of working in low risk confined spaces within the principles set out by the National Occupational Standards and will cover the following topics:

- Legislation relating to confined spaces
- Understand the Classifications between different confined spaces
- Principles of confined space hazards
- Risk assessment awareness for confined spaces
- Using tools and equipment safely
- Atmospheric monitoring procedures and principles
- Safe procedures at work
- Preparation for entry, working and exiting low risk confined spaces
- Confined space hygiene principles
- Understanding and dealing with confined space emergencies
