What is a High Risk Confined Space?

The definition of a high risk confined space exists where there is a hazard present that cannot be managed or eliminated. The candidate will be expected to carry out their task with the risk present which maybe of a toxic nature. For high risk environments the person must wear full breathing apparatus (SCBA)

High risk environments are complex, require planning and require specific controls and rescue arrangements.

Who is the Course Suitable For?

Persons who need to work in confined spaces which have been classified as high risk. The course provides the training and assessment that anyone working in these environments will require.

What are the Course Objectives?

The 6150-03/53 aims to teach learners how to:

- Prepare to work safely in high risk confined spaces
- Enter and exit confined spaces safely
- Prepare and use self-contained open circuit breathing apparatus in accordance with manufacturer's specifications
- Use equipment and tools safely and in accordance with manufacturer's specifications
- Follow procedures and work safely
- Deal with emergencies

What is Covered in the Course?

Training involves the use of SCBA (escape and working duration) with gas detection equipment.

As part of the course, delegates will study the following:

- Definition and classifications of a confined space
- Specified risks
- Regulations and duties, preventing the need for entry
- Risk assessment
- Identifying hazards
- Atmospheric hazards and gases
- Use of gas detectors
- Safe systems of work
- Work permits
- Inspection and the use of escape sets and working duration breathing apparatus
- Selection and use of harnesses
- Safe use of tripods winches and fall arrest equipment
- Carrying out pre and post hygiene routines

What Assessments Are There?

The 6150-03/53 training course is assessed through a written and practical assessment which must be passed to gain the qualification from City and Guilds.

Are There Any Entry Requirements?

Candidates must be physically fit.

What Are The Reading Requirements?

All candidates are encouraged to make themselves familiar with regulations and legislation relating to confined spaces prior to studying this course.
