This qualification is for persons that wish to carry out top man duties for operations which involve Medium Risk confined spaces. If you would like to study for an industry recognised qualification, this course could be for you.

Who is the Course Suitable For?

Anyone who wants to work in an environment which has a medium risk confined space, in a Top Man role, who does not enter the confined space would be an ideal candidate for this course.

This course is suitable for anyone that works in the construction, industrial, utility and chemical industries. The qualification provides proof of training to employers and competence in the role of Top Man in a non-entry capacity in a Medium risk environment.

What is Covered in the Course?

As confined spaces can be hazardous, training is provided for various different roles.

In the medium risk Top Man role candidates focus on reviewing and understanding risk assessments for working within confined spaces, the difference between the classification of confined spaces, informing staff of their responsibilities, establishing a safe zone, ensuring correct communication facilities are in place, performing gas monitoring and reacting to emergency situations. The following learning modules are covered:

- Receiving a task for confined space work
- Organising a safety zone around the space
- Confirming risk assessment and safe working systems
- Controlling the entry and exists of confined spaces
- Dealing with emergencies
- Confined space classification
- Assemble, inform and deploy staff to tasks
- Establishing onsite and offsite communication
- Opening and confirming the confined space risk level
- Performing gas monitoring checks
- Recovering workers from the space safely and closing it safely
- Hygiene procedures
- Emergency situations
